## College of Fellows

The College of Fellows is the grouping of the Fellows of the Institute for the purpose of giving the Institute, through the Council, the benefit of the combined wisdom and views of the Fellows as senior members of the Institute. The College of Fellows is advisory to the Council and holds no statutory or constitutional authority over affairs of the Institute, accepting any such authority as may be specifically delegated to it by Council.

Three meetings are held per year, which are convened by the Chairman or the President. The College will assist and advise Council on the awarding of Life Memberships, Honorary Fellowships and Fellowships. Fellowships are often selected industry leader's elected to Fellows by Council on an annual basis.
