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IHI Hospitality Management Awards

Established in 1966, the Irish Hospitality Institute (IHI) is the professional membership body for those working in the hospitality, tourism, and catering sectors in Ireland. Since its inception, the IHI has championed professional development and lifelong learning through seminars, conferences, networking events, and a range of management training and development initiatives.

The annual IHI Hospitality Management Awards (HMAs) is a prestigious event that celebrates excellence within our industry by honouring its greatest asset—our people. By nominating a manager or colleague, you are recognising their dedication, professionalism, and commitment to the hospitality industry, and offering them the opportunity to be acknowledged with a highly respected award.

The HMAs are designed to recognise individual achievement, focusing on professionalism, dedication, and excellence. Nominees are assessed through a rigorous judging process that evaluates leadership, technical expertise, continuous learning, and the innovation and enthusiasm they bring to their roles.

A panel of IHI Judges is made up of senior industry figures working to shortlist a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 5 nominees per category. The successful short-listed nominees are called to interview. Each nominee is scored by the judging panel based on their interview and the winner of each award is announced at the IHI Founders Evening & Hospitality Management Awards.

WHO SHOULD BE NOMINATED

A manager with at least two years' experience with overall responsibility for their department within an individual property, catering operation, tourist attraction or visitor experience.

Key Dates

- Nominations Open: Wednesday, 16th July 2025
- Nominations Close: Wednesday, 27th August 2025
- Graduate of the Year Nominations Close: Thursday, 18th September 2025
- Interviews: Monday, 6th & Tuesday, 7th October 2025

Shortlisted nominees will be notified of their interview schedule from Monday, 16th September 2025. Attendance is mandatory. If a nominee cannot be present on the allocated date, their nomination may be withdrawn.

Awards Ceremony

The IHI Founders Evening & Hospitality Management Awards 2025 will take place on Thursday, 27th November 2025, at the Clayton Hotel, Burlington Road, Dublin.

Nomination Process

The IHI HMAs nomination platform (Award Force) will open on the 16th of July, 2025. IHI Members will receive a link to the platform where they will be invited to create a login and commence the nomination process.

Things to Remember

- There are seventeen award categories in which to nominate.
- Nominating recognises the commitment and professionalism of individuals within your team.
- Please read the criteria for the category you are nominating within.
- Be sure your nominee is working within the role you are nominating them for.
- All information provided to the IHI is used only for the awards process.
- We encourage the nominator to make full use of the word count for each question to effectively showcase the nominee's skills and accomplishments.
- Please review your nomination before submission, ensuring all the relevant information is accurate.
- IHI members are eligible to nominate a total of 2 individuals.
- It is imperative that you dedicate time to your nomination and not leave it to the last minute.



HOSPITALITY GRADUATE NOMINATION PROCESS

The nomination form is to be completed by both the nominator and the nominee. *Please note, the CPD and Your Current Role sections are to be completed by the nominee. CPD can include seminars, webinars, short courses, and online training.

WHO SHOULD BE NOMINATED

Universities and Technological Universities will be invited to nominate graduates from Hospitality & Event Management programmes who they believe demonstrate creativity in an academic environment and display an aptitude for success.

CRITERIA, ELIGIBILITY & NOMINATION DETAILS

Criteria:

- Nominated candidates must demonstrate expertise in the following areas:
- Provide an example of learnings from college which have made them more effective managers or supervisors.
- Demonstrate excellence in customer care
- Display strong interpersonal and communication skills within your team
- Display leadership skills be they in a college project or work situation
- Display awareness and understanding of industry trends.
- Identify and give examples of key achievements in your current role.

Eligibility:

- Nominees must be graduates of the 2024 graduating class from a Hospitality and Event Management programme up to and including Honours Degree level.
- Nominations should be made by a College representative.
- Following receipt of completed nominations, a shortlist will be drawn up by an independent industry representative adjudication panel.
- Shortlisted candidates will then be invited to interview.
